

HOW TO BECOME AN ELECTION JUDGE



If you are a registered Democratic or Republican voter, **attend your political party's precinct caucus every two years** to express your interest in serving as an election judge. Contact your political party directly for more information.

Douglas County Elections welcomes interested citizens to serve as temporary election workers, called **Election Judges**. This is a unique opportunity to get involved in your local government and play a role in the democratic process.

LOCATIONS

Election Judges may be assigned to a role at the Douglas County Elections office in Castle Rock or at one of the Voter Service and Polling Center (VSPC) locations across Douglas County.

SCHEDULING




All roles include **training and scheduled shifts that generally run from one month before Election Day through one week after.**

TYPICAL DAY: 3-6 hour shift between 8 AM - 5 PM




ELECTION DAY: 8-10 hour shift between 6:45 AM and 11:30 PM


Serving as an election judge is a temporary, paid position with Douglas County that is limited to the duration of each election cycle.
