



Notice of Prairie Dog Management

July 15, 2024

Douglas County Division of Open Space and Natural Resources will be conducting prairie dog management activities on four properties beginning in August 2023. Douglas County must manage these populations to resolve conflicts with various Open Space management objectives on the various sites and to prevent encroachment onto the adjacent properties. These efforts are part of a larger management plan to maintain viable populations of prairie dogs in Douglas County while reducing conflicts with neighbors, agricultural operations, and other open space management objectives.

The properties receiving management action may include:

- Subdivision parcels within Cherry Creek Highlands
- Hidden Mesa Open Space
- Spruce Meadows Open Space
